Otto Fenichel (now residing at Jecna 18, Praha, Czechoslovakia), and at present a member of the Vienna Psychoanalytic Society and leader of a branch of that Society in Prague (formerly a member of the Berlin Psychoanalytic Society and of the teaching staff of the Berlin Psychoanalytic Institute) for a period of three (3) years, beginning on the first day of the calendar month next succeeding his arrival at Los Angeles, California, for the purpose of teaching the science of psychoanalysis to the members of the Study Group by means of lectures and seminars.

Dr. Fenichel is to have at least one-half of his time for private teaching of qualified and licensed physicians in the technique of psychoanalysis and private educational work with children and with teachers and parents, for which he may earn additional compensation.

The compensation which we agree to pay is Thirty-six Hundred Dollars (\$3600.00) per year, payable Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) on the first day of each month.
