ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

1. The name of this corporation is Los Angeles
Institute for Psychoanalysis.

2. The purposes for which this corporation is
formed are as follows:

A. To train and teach properly qualified
physicians in the theory, technique and applications
of psychoanalysis.

B. To acquaint other qualified individuals
in related professional, academic and educational
fields with aspects of psychoanalysis pertinent to
their fields.

C. To conduct research in the developments
in the theory, technique and applications of psycho-
analysis.

D. To affiliate and cooperate with other
groups and associations for the furtherance of the
purposes of this corporation.

E. To provide a consultation service and
facilities for treatment of personality disturbances
in individuals of limited means.

F. To collect and raise money, funds and other property or securities for the furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

G. To receive property by gift, devise or bequest and subject to the laws regulating the transfer of property by will and otherwise to acquire and hold all property, real or personal, including shares of stock, bonds and securities of other corporations.

H. To act as trustee under any trust incidental to the principal objects of the corporation and to receive, hold, administer and expend funds and property subject to such trust.

I. To make gifts and appropriations necessary to carry out the objects and purposes of the corporation.

J. In general, to do all things authorized to be done by the general nonprofit corporation law of the State of California, whether or not specifically enumerated in these Articles of Incorporation, and to do all acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs of the corporation.

K. This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.
