## FIRST DRAFT OF A PROPOSAL FOR AN

## OPERATIONAL AGREEMENT RETWEEN MEMBERS OF THE EDUCATION COMMITTEE OF THE LOS ANGELES INSTITUTE FOR PSYCHOANALYS IS

- has been formed and has now been recognized by the American Psychoanalytic Association. These same three members have stated their intention to form another psychoanalytic institute in Los Angeles, pending recognition by the American Psychoanalytic Association.
