ONE:

The name of this corporation is:

TWO:

The purpose for which this corporation is formed are:

- (a) To establish and maintain an institution of learning in the field of psychoanalysis.
- (b) To teach and to promote the study and practice of psychoanalysis.
- (c) To encourage research in all fields having to do with psychoanalysis.
- (d) To foster the integration of psychoanalysis with other branches of medicine.
- (e) To provide means and facilities for rendering a service to the community in the application of psychoanalytic medicine.
 - (f) To promote and foster the training of psychoanalysts.
- (g) To provide the means and facilities to accomplish any or all of the aforesaid purposes and objects.

THREE:

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General NonProfit Corporation Law of the State of California.


The county in the State of California where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located is Los Angeles County.

In no event shall any part of the net earnings of the corporation ever inure to the benefit of any private shareholder, member, or individual, whether upon dissolution of the corporation or otherwise.


