Dear Dr. Daniels:

I am directed by the Executive Council of the Psychoanalytic Study Group of Los Angeles to inform you that the Council has accepted your resignation from the Study Group, and also to inform you that the following sentences are included in the minutes of the Council Meeting of January 23rd, 1942:

"The Executive Council, in accepting the resignation of Edgar E. Daniels, Ph.D., takes cognizance of Dr. Daniels' telegram of resignation of November 8, 1941, and his telephone conversations at that time with Mrs. Deri and with Dr. Simmel.

As far as Dr. Daniels' reproaches against Mrs. Deri are concerned, the Council expresses its conviction that Mrs. Deri has acted entirely correctly throughout the difficulties with the late Dr. Irene Haenel, and emphasizes its complete confidence in Mrs. Deri as a personality and as a psychoanalyst."
