Minutes of the Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Lawrence J. Friedman, President, at 7:30 p.m. There were thirty-five members present.

1. The minutes of the meeting of April 21, 1960, were accepted as distributed.
2. Membership Committee:
 - (a) Dr. Edwin F. Price was elected to Active Membership.
 - (b) Dr. Futterman, Chairman of the Membership Committee, announced that Dr. Gottfried Bloch had been elected to Accredited Membership by mail ballot. Dr. Bloch was introduced to the Society.
3. Dr. Rangell, Executive Councillor, summarized the meetings of the Membership held at the Annual Meeting in Atlantic City. The nominees for various offices of the APA were read and will be distributed. The matter of accreditation was discussed much further, and the issue is being sent out for a mail ballot to the membership. Included in this ballot will be the resolutions of both the Board on Professional Standards and the Executive Council voicing their disapproval of accreditation at this time. The material gathered by the Central Fact Gathering Committee will be made available for appropriate research workers, but it was voted not to proceed with publication of the data because of the many difficulties which were involved. A new committee was set up to study the matter of tax deductibility for training and supervising analyses. Thirty-eight new members were elected to the APA, including Dr. Hilda Rollman-Branch from our Society. There were five Life Fellows who received Life Certificates. These were the highlights. Other data is on record.
4. Dr. Dorn reported that replies had been received in regard to the charter plane to Europe in 1961. There are, at the present time, seventy-six either "would definitely go" or "very interested." Information regarding this plan will be sent out when it is available.
5. Dr. Frances Cottingham, recently elected to Guest Membership, was introduced to the membership and was welcomed.
6. New Business:
 - (a) Dr. Friedman announced the slate of nominees and reminded the membership that additional names could be presented at the next meeting according to the By-Laws. Dr. Greenson took issue at the method of selecting the slate in that the Nominating Committee did not poll enough members. Dr. Tausend answered by indicating that requests had been made and were considered.

The meeting was adjourned at 8 p.m.
