Subject: "On Sublimation"

Sublimation is a result of an Ego defence against pre-genital impulses. Only such pregenital impulses can be sublimated which have their source in bodily organs subserving self-preservation. Genital impulses cannot be sublimated. Pregenital impulses which are derived and split off from functions of bodily organs yield the energy for human achievement ("Leistung"). Genital impulses subserve solely the purpose of enjoyment ("Genus")
