

THE PSYCHOANALYTIC STUDY GROUP OF LOS ANGELES

Amendment to By-Laws

To be voted on 25 January 1952

Add: Article VIII

(1) The Psychoanalytic Study Group of Los Angeles shall become a part of the Extension Division of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis, under the name of "Study Group of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis (Extension Division)".

(2) Pursuant to this aim, the above By-Laws of the Study Group are hereby repealed, so that the Study Group shall function according to the By-Laws of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis, and in the Extension Division of said Institute, which is organized by the Director of the Extension Division, subject to approval by the Director of the Institute and the Professional Committee of the Institute.

(3) It is the wish of the Study Group that its functions as a study and discussion group shall be administered by a Program Committee of four, three of whom, including a Chairman, shall be elected by those Members and Scientific Associates of the Institute who are active in the Study Group, and the fourth shall be the Director of the Extension Division ex-officio.

THE PSYCHOANALYTIC STUDY GROUP OF LOS ANGELES

Amendment to Bylaws

To be voted on 25 January 1952

Article VIII

- (1) The Psychoanalytic Study Group of Los Angeles shall become a part of the Extension Division of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis under the name of "Study Group of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis (Extension Division)".
- (2) Pursuant to this aim, the above Bylaws of the Study Group are hereby repealed, so that the Study Group shall function according to the Bylaws of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis, and in the Extension Division of said Institute, which is organized by the Director of the Extension Division, subject to approval by the Director of the Institute and the Professional Committee of the Institute.
- (3) It is the wish of the Study Group that its functions as a study and discussion group shall be administered by a Program Committee of four, three of whom, including a Chairman, shall be elected by those Members and Scientific Associates of the Institute who are active in the Study Group and the fourth shall be the Director of the Extension Division ex-officio.

(4) Those of the present Members, Associate Members and Permanent Guests of the Study Group who are not at present Members of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis shall become Associate Members (Scientific Associates, or Affiliates) of said Institute, subject to election by the Board of Trustees of said Institute, with dues for such memberships to be set by the Institute at levels no higher at the present time than have been paid in the Study Group most recently.

(5) Financial management and secretarial operations of the Study Group shall become functions of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis (though they may be duly delegated).

(6) The Otto Fenichel Memorial Library of the Psychoanalytic Study Group of Los Angeles shall become part of the Library of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis, with the exception of such books and journals as may be of special interest to the School for Nursery Years, to which these shall be donated. It is the wish of the Study Group that the Library of the Institute shall henceforth be known as the Ernst Simmel and Otto Fenichel Memorial Library (this of course subject to the approval of the Trustees of the Institute). The Library of the Institute will be open to use by all classes of members of the Institute, subject to the regulations of the Institute.

(7) Funds of the Study Group previously earmarked for the School for Nursery Years should be paid over to said School; and the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis has already guaran-

(1) Those of the present Members, Associate Members and
 Honorary Members of the Study Group who are not at present
 Members of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis shall
 become Associate Members (Regular, Associate, or Affiliate)
 of said Institute, subject to election by the Board of Trustees
 of said Institute, with due regard for such membership to be set by
 the Institute at a rate no higher of the present time than have
 been paid in the Study Group most recently.

(2) Financial management and secretarial operations of
 the Study Group shall become functions of the Los Angeles Insti-
 tute for Psychoanalysis (though they may be duly delegated).

(3) The Otto Fenichel Memorial Library of the Psychoanaly-
 tical Society of Los Angeles shall become part of the library
 of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis, with the excep-
 tion of such books and journals as may be of special interest to
 the School for Nursery Years, to which these shall be donated.
 It is the wish of the Study Group that the library of the Insti-
 tute shall henceforth be known as the Ernst Simmel and Otto
 Fenichel Memorial Library (this of course subject to the approval
 of the Trustees of the Institute). The library of the Institute
 will be open to use by all classes of members of the Institute,
 subject to the regulations of the Institute.

(4) Funds of the Study Group previously contributed for the
 School for Nursery Years should be paid over to said School, and
 the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis has already finan-

teed to the School for Nursery Years at least as much financial support as has been given to said School by the Study Group in past years.

(8) The Study Group believes that its purpose can remain the same as heretofore, as expressed in Article II of its previous By-Laws: To study psychoanalysis as developed by Sigmund Freud and his School; to promote and disseminate the knowledge thereof; and to encourage the application of psychoanalytic knowledge to other branches of science, by bringing scientists in various fields into close contact with psychoanalysts. And the Study Group also believes that its functions of holding scientific meetings and discussions in appropriate fields can continue as hitherto. These purposes and functions can be better carried out within the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis and with the support of the facilities of said Institute, and therefore in full harmony with the aims and functions of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis.
