Minutes of the Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 p.m., by Dr. Vatz, Chairman. Present were Drs. Brunswick, Evans, Fenichel, Fielding, Friedman, McGuire, Van der Heide, and Dr. Van Dam for the Committee on Child Analysis. Present from the faculty: Drs. Atkins, Bail, Gottesman, Leavitt, Malin, and Rollman-Branch.

1. The minutes of the meeting of October 6, 1966, were approved as distributed.

2. Candidates:

- a. Dr. Brunie has started supervision with Dr. Brunswick.
- b. Dr. Hoedemaker started supervision with Dr. Van der Heide.
- c. Dr. McCorquodale started supervision with Dr. Lihn.
- d. Dr. Rosenblum started supervision with Dr. Van der Heide.
- e. Dr. Mendelsohn's analysis with Dr. Vatz has been terminated.
- f. Dr. Flynn successfully completed Colloquium I.
- g. Dr. Hellinger successfully completed Colloquium I.
- h. Dr. Vatz reported on his interview with Dr. Ritvo:

Motion: Dr. Friedman moved, s/Dr. Fenichel, m/c (5 in favor, 2 opposed), that Dr. Ritvo be given permission to take Colloquium II, but that he be reminded that Colloquium II is not synonymous with graduation and that he must have further analysis in order to graduate.

- i. Dr. Hofmann, an accepted applicant for over two years, failed to answer a letter inquiring about his plans to start training analysis. It was decided that if at some future date he should communicate a desire to start training, he will have to reapply to the Institute.
- j. Dr. Lieberman was given permission to take Colloquium I. His examiners will be Dr. McGuire and a member of the faculty.
- k. Dr. McCorquodale's request for a second supervised case was postponed to the next meeting of the Education Committee since he has so few hours of supervision with his first case and his request was received too late to obtain a report from his supervisor.

- l. Dr. Bender was given permission to start a third supervised case
  - m. Dr. R. Mintz was given permission to start a fourth supervised case.
  - n. Dr. Kalman's progress in training was discussed at the request of his analyst. The Chairman will talk with Dr. Kalman about this discussion.
  - o. Dr. Amador, having fulfilled all the requirements of training, was graduated.
  - p. Dr. Kurth graduated; however, the Chairman will discuss with Dr. Kurth misgivings in regard to his graduation expressed by some members of the Education Committee.
  - q. Dr. Purchard was not graduated because only two of his cases were under supervision for 50 hours or more.
  - r. Dr. Tedesco was not graduated since he also needs more supervisory hours on his third case.
3. Admissions Committee:
- a. Dr. Heinicke:

The Admissions Committee was in favor of accepting Dr. Heinicke's application for training for research, providing he is fulfilling the requirements of The American. The Chairman, while in New York for the Midwinter Meetings, will discuss with Drs. Wallerstein and Stein the attitude of The American towards Dr. Heinicke's now being in the private practice of child analysis and why he was dropped as a research candidate in San Francisco. Acceptance of Dr. Heinicke for training by the Education Committee will depend on the outcome of this discussion.
  - b. Dr. Worthen:

It was the decision of the Education Committee that Dr. Worthen should have further interviews before final action is taken on his application. His interviewers will be Drs. McGuire and Van der Heide.
4. Committees Appointed:
- a. Admissions:

The following were approved by the Education Committee to serve as the Admissions Committee for the year 1966-1967:

Drs. Fielding, Kupper, Lihn, Van der Heide, Brandchaft, Goldberg, Malin, Rosow, and Rubin. Dr. Vatz will serve as Chairman.
  - b. Curriculum/Faculty:

Drs. Aronson; Atkins; McGuire; Williams; and Van der Heide, Chairman, were approved by the Education Committee to be the Curriculum/Faculty Committee for the year 1966-1967. Dr. Vatz will serve in an ex-officio capacity.

- b. Dr. Fielding's term as a training analyst expires in December, 1966; the vote on a five-year term for Dr. Fielding will be taken at the January meeting of the Education Committee.
- c. Dr. Lihn submitted his resignation as a Training-Analyst Trustee. The Education Committee can take no action in regard to electing another Training-Analyst Trustee until Dr. Lihn's resignation is accepted by the Board of Trustees.
- d. Drs. Rangell and Van der Heide were elected representatives to the Pre-Congress Conference on Psychoanalytic Training. Dr. Fenichel was elected alternate. Dr. Rangell's name will be submitted for consideration as Chairman of a discussion group.

7. Child-Analysis Committee:

The Child-Analysis Committee requested the Education Committee to instruct the Fellows to the Board on Professional Standards to approve the recommendations of the Board regarding the establishment of standards for training in child analysis.

Motion: It was moved, seconded, and carried, that the Fellows to the Board on Professional Standards approve the standards recommended by the Board for training in child analysis.

The meeting was adjourned at 10 p.m.
