Speaker: Dr. John Klauber

Dr. Klauber is a member of the British Psycho-Analytic Society and a training analyst, Hamstead Child Therapy Course.

Subject: "An Attempt to isolate a typical Form of Transference in neurotic Depression. A Description of three Stages"

Dr. Klauber's paper discusses the transference reactions in the opening phase, the middle phase, and the final phase in the analysis of depressed patients. The elements of transference which Dr. Klauber considers "concern chiefly the relationship of various parts of the ego to one another, or rather the relations of the part-object representations within the ego to each other and to the Ego-Ideal, or ideal self, and the way in which these images are projected in the transference." He also attempts to "bring forward some postulates concerned with the nature of the original object-relationships on which such an ego-structure is founded."
