SUBJECT: Agreement

I have no corrections to make on the draft of the agreement; however, I only yesterday was informed of the fact that they will not be able to get recognition from the Veterans Administration. I was informed that there is a rule which makes it impossible for any institution to be recognized that did not already exist in 1944, or at least at the inception of our operation. This means that for the benefit of those students who are entitled to the V. A. payments, we shall have to keep indefinitely the members of the staff of the other institute even if recognized as independent otherwise in our newly printed pamphlet. I have not been able to figure out yet how this may influence the whole situation and I don't know either what bearing it might have on the agreement on financial matters that we are negotiating. In addition to the fact that this is going to be a very undesirable situation generally speaking, I think it merits some more consideration before we make a final decision on the financial agreement.
