

A G R E E M E N T

Agreement between the
LOS ANGELES INSTITUTE FOR PSYCHOANALYSIS
and the
INSTITUTE FOR PSYCHOANALYTIC MEDICINE OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

The Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis gives to
the Institute for Psychoanalytic Medicine of Southern California
_____ representing three-sevenths of the cash balance
of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis as of June 30, 1950,
under the following conditions:

If and when the Institute for Psychoanalytic Medicine of
Southern California receives from the American Psychoanalytic
Association recognition as a psychoanalytic institute, the Los
Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis agrees to give to the Institute
for Psychoanalytic Medicine of Southern California three-sevenths of
the cost of the library and three-sevenths of the value of the
furnishings and equipment of the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis,
both of these figures reckoned as of June 30, 1950; and all persons
holding positions with the Institute for Psychoanalytic Medicine of
Southern California agree to resign at this same time from any and
all positions in the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis.

If the American Psychoanalytic Association refuses recognition
to the Institute for Psychoanalytic Medicine of Southern California,
this Institute for Psychoanalytic Medicine of Southern California
agrees to return to the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis the

balance remaining of the fund now presented to the Institute for
 Psychoanalytic Medicine of Southern California by the Los Angeles
 Institute for Psychoanalysis, together with an accounting of the
 expenditures made from the fund in the meantime.
