Subject: "Ego Ideal"

This paper describes the terminological and conceptual confusion surrounding the ego ideal and critically reviews the pertinent recent literature. An attempt is made to establish a working definition of ego ideal and to set the concept within the framework of the structural theory. It is concluded that the concept ego ideal is a valuable and necessary part of the structural theory and is clinically pertinent especially to considerations of tact and timing.
