Minutes of the Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Dr. Sperling, President. There were thirty-two members present.

1. The minutes of the meeting of December 20, 1962, were approved as distributed.
2. Formal Vote on Donation of the Harvey A. Lewis, M. D., Library to the Los Angeles Institute for Psychoanalysis:

It was moved by Dr. Brunswick, S/Dr. Rosengarten that the library of Dr. Harvey A. Lewis be donated to the Institute. M/C unanimously.

3. Announcements:

- a. Letter from Societe Psychanalytique de Paris:

The Society Psychanalytique de Paris announces a symposium on "Le Fantasme" on Sunday, February 24, 1963. This announcement is on the bulletin board in the Society office.

- b. The Tavistock Institute of Human Relations announces a one-day scientific meeting on Sunday, July 21, 1963, which will immediately precede the Pre-Congress Scientific Programme of the British Psychoanalytical Society.
- c. Dr. Walsh informed the membership of the forthcoming programs under the auspices of the Extension Division and invited the membership to attend the meetings and to participate in the programs as speakers.
 - 1) Saturday, February 16, 1963: the Third Annual Institute for Teachers will be held in conjunction with the Reiss-Davis Clinic for Child Guidance. Dr. E. James Anthony will speak on "'It Hurts Me More Than it Hurts You' - Discipline is a Two-Way Process." The Institute will take place at the Beverly Hills High School and starts at 9:30 a.m.
 - 2) Tuesday, February 19, 1963: Dr. Greenson will speak on "Questions Please - on Psychoanalysis."
 - 3) On Friday, March 8, 1963, Dr. Bernard Diamond of San Francisco will speak on "Psychoanalysis in the Courtroom."
 - 4) In April Mr. Donald Freed, director and teacher of drama, will speak on the dramatic arts.
- d. Dr. Heinz Kohut of The American Psychoanalytic Association has invited

suggestions from individuals as well as the Society for nominations for the offices of President-Elect and Councilor-at-Large, to be elected at the fall, 1963, meeting of The American Psychoanalytic Association.

4. New Business:

Dr. Kandelin, Chairman of the Committee for the History of the Society, reviewed the work of the Committee as to the recording and transcribing of personal reminiscences of early members for the archives, which are to be assembled. The Committee wishes to interview approximately ten people by June, 1963; and this requires the membership's approval of funds estimated at approximately \$500. The Institute has indicated a willingness to contribute half of this expense. M/Dr. Rosow, S/Dr. Leventhal that the Committee be authorized to expend half the cost of this project. M/C unanimously.
